

Welcome to an introduction to Mechanical Air ~ A most radical gesture for the composition of contemporary music art performance.


Mechanical Air is a collaboration between one of England's most innovative avant-garde experimental flautists Gavin Osborn and performance artist Michael Mayhew ~ 'One of the most original and searching artists presently working in the UK' (John E Mcgrath ~ Director National Theatre of Wales)

This partnership has been arrived at through a desire to offer a new insight into the generation of contemporary music by bringing together dynamic combinational working processes and practices into this new work.

Osborn commissioned Mayhew in 2007 to generate a new collection of Hyper ~ Graphic Scores for Trio Atem, 'The Alchemy Collection'. This PRSF funded commission led Mayhew to be nominated by PRSF for a **British Composer of the year Award** in 2008.

Mayhew is generating some of the most radical visual notational systems, 'The Hyper~Graphic', that in turn produce open and revolutionary cross-disciplinary performance.

This document offers you an insight into the Hyper ~ Graphic Score as a visual tool for the composition of new music art performance.


## The Hyper ~ Graphic Score ~

We realise that we are at a specific point of human transition. We are facing a series of dramatic global Happening political, economic, and ecological.


How do we as artists engage with what we as a species are being faced with?

We turned to John Cage for inspiration and reason for an engagement with the Hyper~Graphic Score to offer new, radical and dynamic insights in order to 'change' how we see, interpret, visualise and notate the challenges we face now.

When it comes to traditional musical notation Cage is quoted as saying



"It has only to do with reading and reading something equivalent to Greek or Latin because the notation is no longer useful for music of the Twentieth Century. It's only useful for previous centuries."





With the rise of visual culture within broader 'hyper-culture', and the evolution of the language of the visual & its increased dominance over the last 100 years, this quote from Cage is potentially more apt within the 'now' than ever before.

This period of 'now', the early part of the twenty-first century has witnessed an explosion of visual language & communication within the digital, screen based forms of advertising / gaming / software development for sound composition – sound is now a highly visualised form of graphic hyper communication.



Has this led to a democratisation of sound & image production?

Has the increase use of technology generated a homogenisation and industrialisation of sound?

The population has become a sophisticated readership of a visual language that often needs decoding at high speed.

Does music need classical notation any longer?

Has notation been challenged?

Should anyone be able to compose and read music?

The Hyper-Graphic notational system opens up a series of pertinent and leading enquiries into the authorship of creative notational systems and who is identified as author, composure, or choreographer.

The Hyper-Graphic as a form of notation does not demarcate between forms but encourages dynamic inter-disciplinary discourse between art practices, dissolving the barriers that often exist between languages of expression.


In Search of Awe

Mayhew's work is leading the way in the conception of a new form of compositional notation that is also being engaged with by dancers and performers as inspiration for choreographic sequencing of the body in space. The Hyper-Graphic Score is the visualisation of sound, movement, texture, pitch, colour and note. It is open to a series of interpretations and choices; its very nature requests all collaborators to negotiate, collaborate, exchange and participate. It encourages for the discovery of a unique voice of expression, specific to space, place and people.

The Hyper-Graphic is a visual language being employed to reveal, expose, translate, patterns, structures, directions, rhythms, transitions, declines, inclines through lines, colour and visual inflections. This enables the player, dancer or performer to shape space and time within performance time in a unique and individualistic manner.

**Mechanical Air** combines and collaborates with live music, dance and the visual image to generate a work that takes influence from the most essential aspects of what it means to be human.

The partnership between Mayhew & Osborn is pushing the boundaries of the Hyper-Graphic into new arenas of collaboration.






